


Weather



The warmest month of the year in Alicante is August, with temperature of more than 30 °C and a minimum of 22 °C.




The coldest month of the year in Alicante is January, with an average minimum temperature of 8 °C and a maximum of 17 °C.




Rains concentrated mainly in the fall (from September to November)



PORT CITY

Small fishing boats and pleasure boats dock in this port of Carthaginian origin, in addition to concentrating a large part of the city's leisure offer.




LOCAL TRADICIONAL CELEBRATIONS OR FESTIVITIES
